

Palestinian Art: How & Why

INTRODUCTION:

Scope:

Palestinian arts from the late nineteenth century to the contemporary period. Since time is at a premium, the ISP will focus on historical foundations in addition to contemporary thematics.

Method:

The seminar will have a professional practice orientation where participants will have responsibility to animate the seminars. Theoretical and scholarly issues can be addressed as part of the discussions.

Participants' responsibilities & assignments:

Required texts are divided thematically and are to be read through by all participants. Read for main argument, with notes taken on the main points, questions to be asked during the seminar. Supplemental readings texts are optional.

Iconography compilation and presentation is the responsibility of participants.
