

A marriage of memory and art

An exhibition



Ginane Makki Bacho was born in Beirut in 1947. Between April 11 and May 31, Ayyam Gallery Beirut will be hosting an exhibition of her work.

The exhibition, which is called *Afterimage* presents a highly personal series of paintings which Makki Bacho refers to as her 'memoirs'. She uses personal photos, collaged together to create flashes back to her past. These flashes overlap and merge, and not only allow the viewer glimpses back into the artist's history, but also into the wider narrative of Lebanon's turbulent past.

Makki Bacho has had recent solo exhibitions at ArtCircle, Agial Art Gallery, and the French Cultural Center in Beirut; along with group exhibitions at Sursock Museum, Beirut Art Center, Fa Gallery in Kuwait and the Biennale Bibliotheca Alexandrina in Alexandria.
