
During their two-part session, Ayman and Riham will give us insights into their artform, through which body painting and photography have been merged, and illustrate the process of creating photography as a fine art.

During his three-part session, the photographer often referred to as the "Magician" or "The lighting wizard" will explode the myth that dramatic, quality lighting is a gift bestowed on the chosen few. Damian will take you by the hand on this imaging odyssey starting at the most important point, the point all too often missed or ignored by others - the concept!
